Transport Fee of 602 no of students / Month = Rs. 12,19,807/Cost spent on diesel - Rs. 3,80,634/-

- For every one hundred rupees transport fee collection, 31.2% spent on diesel head.
- ➤ 31.2% on every child transport fee will be refunded until school re-open.
- First term (April, June & July) classes are going online.
- ➤ The refund of diesel cost of first term will be refunded before 30th July 2020.
- ➤ Even during online classes bus running for teacher commute to school to take online classes & collection/delivery of class work note books BUT School is not calculating these cost while refunds.
- > School spending additional cost for online classes for all teachers data card re-charge, Microsoft server, ... etc but school never asked from parents additional cost.
- ➤ In India, our school is only school started online classes from 6th April and not cutting down any portion or teachers work including class work correction and monthly assessment.
- In India, our school is first school, teachers are taking online classes from school and until now it's ONLY SCHOOL, ALL teachers coming regularly to school even the pandemic.
- Transport of any school always running under loss because under utilisation.

All the schools manage loss from term fees to provide transport facilities and cover up little bit from May month diesel saving.

Our school is committed to do best to our children. Still, parents are not happy with any of our system, parents are free to choose other schools.
