“Sports Activity”

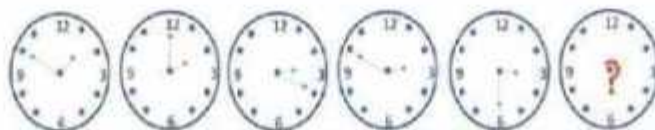

MYSTERY CHAMBER

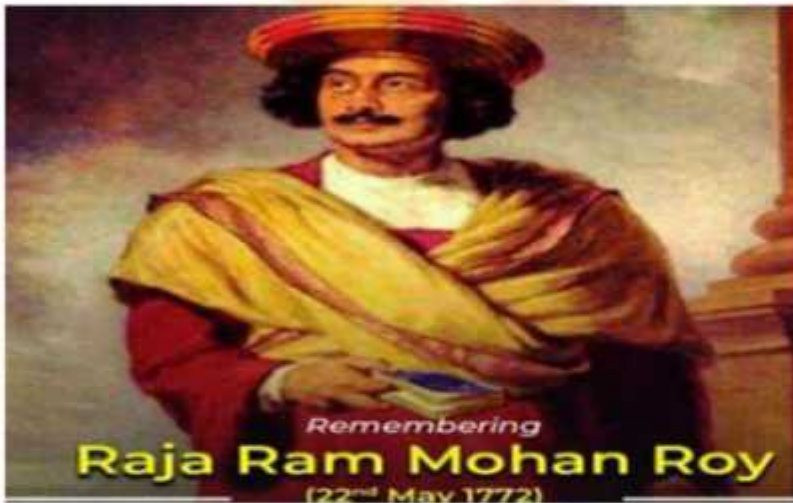
Math Logic Puzzles

राजा राम मोहन राँय

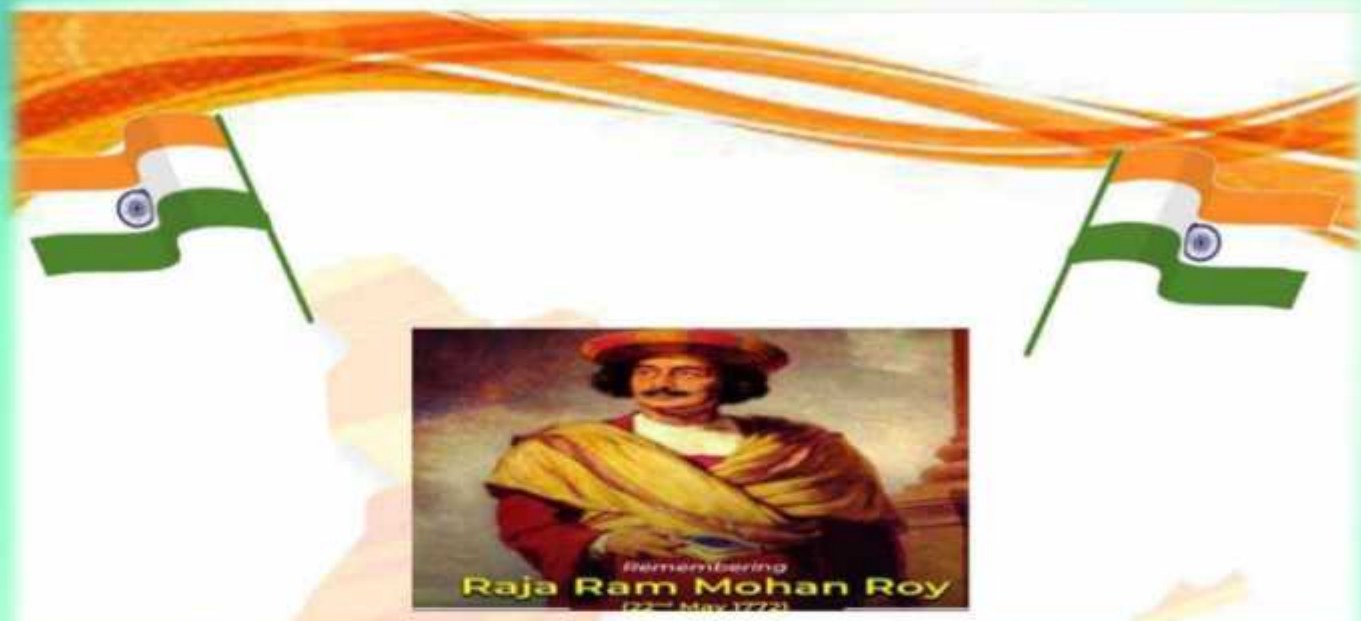


राजा राम मोहन राय को आधुनिक भारत का पहला प्रमुख समाज सुधारक और भारतीय पुनर्जागरण का पिता कहा जाता है. उन्हें देश में सती प्रथा और बाल विवाह को खत्म करवाने के लिए उनके विशेष योगदान के जाना जाता है .22 मई को उनकी जयंती हैराममोहन . राय का जन्म बंगाल प्रांत के हुगली जिले के राधानगर में 22 मई 1772 को हुआ था.

- राजा राम मोहन राय ने सुधारवादी धार्मिक संघों की कल्पना सामाजिक और राजनीतिक परिवर्तन के उपकरणों के रूप में की।
- उन्होंने वर्ष 1815 में आत्मीय सभा, वर्ष 1821 में कलकत्ता यूनिटेरियन एसोसिएशन और वर्ष 1828 में ब्रह्म सभा (जो बाद में ब्रह्म समाज बन गया) की स्थापन

Known as the '**Maker of Modern India**', Raja Ram Mohan Roy worked to ensure the practice of Sati and Child Marriage was legally banned in India

Raja Ram Mohan Roy was a legendary socio - religious reformer who had challenged Hindu Orthodox and played a pivotal role in abolishing Sati and child marriage in 1830s. He was also a staunch feminist, who had advocated for the women's rights to property in inheritance.

He believed that Social Reformation of India will be achieved only by the education and established several institutes that supported the inclusion of western learning into an Indian education.
