ಜೈ ಹಿಂದ್ ಜೈ ಕರ್ನಾಟಕ ಮಾತೆ









Born in Mangalore in 1903, Kamaladevi Chattopadhyay was an independent-minded feminist and freedom fighter. Her mother, a liberal Saraswat Brahmin, was her main inspiration. She befriended several notable thinkers and freedom fighters, including her parents Mahadev Govind Ranade and Gopal Krishna Gokhale, and women's rights activists Ramabai Ranade and Ani Besant. Because of this, young Kamaladevi became a devotee of the Swadeshi National Movement at an early age. She was in London when she heard about Mahatma Gandhi's call for noncooperation movement. She returned to India and joined the Seva Dal. She was made in charge of the women's wing of the Seva Dal. He was the first organizing secretary of AIWC. Kamaladevi Chattopadhyay was also a part of Salt Satyagraha. She was committed to feminism throughout her life and never shied away from opposing men who violated women's rights. Her work was so successful that she became India's first woman to contest for a legislative seat. She received the Padma Bhushan and Padma Vibhushan from the Government of India.
