Experiential Learning- Visit to Fire Station and Police Station

Class: I - III

Subject: Math and Science

As part of our experiential learning program, our students visited the local Fire Station and Police Station to gain real-world knowledge about community helpers and their essential roles in society.

Fire Station Visit:

At the fire station, students had the opportunity to interact with the fire-fighters and observe their equipment, such as fire engines, hoses and safety gear. The fire-fighters explained how they respond to emergencies, demonstrated the use of fire safety tools, and taught basic fire safety tips. The students were excited to learn about how fire-fighters save lives and protect property during emergencies. This hands-on experience helped them understand the importance of fire safety and the courage it takes to serve as a fire-fighter.

Police Station Visit:

During the police station visit, students were welcomed by friendly police officers who explained their daily duties and the importance of maintaining law and order. The officers gave the students a tour of the station, including the control room and basic equipment used in their work. They also conducted an interactive session where students asked questions about safety, traffic rules and how to handle emergencies. The session aimed to build trust and awareness about the role of police in society.

Subject: Mathematics
